

INFORMATION SHEET / CHECKLIST What you need to provide with a Building Permit application for **Demolition Works**

All plans must be prepared by a registered building practitioner in the appropriate category.

- 1. Appointment of Relevant Building Surveyor Form, where the applicant is the builder (Completed & Signed).
- 2. Application for Building Permit (Form 1) (Completed & Signed).
- 3. Certificate of Title, Plan of subdivision (allotment plans) & the relevant title instruments (Covenant, Section 173 Agreement, MCP etc.). https://www.landata.vic.gov.au/
- 4. Section 29A Consent from the relevant council.
- 5. Full name and contact details (address, email, phone, registration number (for the building practitioners)) of the owner, agent (where applicable), demolisher etc.
- 6. Demolishers certificate of Currency for PL Insurance.
- 7. Demolition procedure/ Safe Work Method statement (SWMS).
- 8. Architectural plans: Dimensioned site plans and elevations, showing setbacks from boundaries, buildings on adjoining properties etc.
- 9. Protection Work Notification (Form 7) and Response (Form 8) where demolition works include party walls or works on boundary line
- 10. Consent where precautions are required over the street alignment.
- 11. Where only part of dwelling is being demolished, structural details or computations showing the remainder of dwelling will be structurally sound

Note: Min \$500, non-refundable deposit (ex GST) is required at appointment of Relevant Building Surveyor and summation of Building Permit Application.
